Article 6.

To see if the Town will vote to require that the compensation of the Town Tax Collector be changed from a percentage of total collections to an annual salary basis, which may include vacation and other leave, and other employee benefits, determined as for other Town employees, effective at and after the 1995 annual Town Meeting.

*The article was moved and seconded as read. Motion carried.*

Article 7.

To see if the Town will vote in the exercise of its home rule powers to require that all fees and service charges received by Town Officials in any official capacity, including that of State Agent, shall be paid over to the Town Treasurer for deposit to the account of the Town, and that all fees which any official is entitled by law or ordinance to retain as her or his own may then be drawn from the Treasury only on the authority of an appropriate warrant signed by at least a majority of the Selectmen.

*Moved and seconded as read. Motion carried.*

Article 8.

To see if the Town will vote to change the terms of the Town Selectmen, Overseers of the Poor and Assessors from one year each to a three-year term each, the terms to be staggered and phased in with the elections held at the 1995 Annual Town Meeting, as follows: elect one First Selectman for a term of three years, elect one Second Selectman for a term of two years, and elect one third Selectman for a term of one year; with all Selectman elections thereafter to be for a term of three years each.
